Please call in advance, 740-654-9923, to make certain staff will be available. All photos will be scanned and returned to you at the time of your visit.

Scanned Civil War photos of soldiers and related community Civil War photos would be used for educational purposes as well as placed in an archive at the Sherman House Museum.

The Fairfield County Civil War 150 Alliance is a collaboration of heritage, arts, and cultural organizations that have partnered together to plan Fairfield County's Civil War sesquicentennial commemoration. The 150th anniversary of the Civil War provides a unique occasion to educate the community about Fairfield County's important contributions to the Civil War, as well as allowing new opportunities to promote area cultural attractions.
