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## **Kids in College Program Expands to Ohio University Pickerington Center**

Lancaster - A program that has been offered at the Ohio University Lancaster Campus for the last 33 years will now also be offered at the Pickerington Center.

*Kids in College* is a program that provides students entering the 4<sup>th</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup> grades the opportunity to get hands-on experience over the summer that reinforces the knowledge and instruction they received in school. It also introduces highly motivated students to a college campus and gives students the chance to interact with university professors. Class enrollment is limited so that students can receive individual attention.

"Children enjoy the individual attention the program provides," said Community and Corporate Learning Administrative Coordinator Maryann Lape. "They have fun in the classes and do not realize they are learning in the process."

The Kids in College program will run at the Pickerington Center from July 23-27. Classes are scheduled from 9:30-11:30 a.m. and 12:30-2:30 p.m. There will be a supervised break for lunch.

"It makes sense to offer a successful children's program to a community that values education, such as Pickerington," said Community and Corporate Learning Center Interim Director, Ron Cullums.

The cost is \$99 per class, plus lab fees. Four different classes will be offered.

1. Ohio Facts and Fun – Come learn more about Ohio's interesting people, places and things in a fun way! This class is all about learning fun facts, trivia and other knowledge about the state of Ohio that you may not have learned at school. You will be creating an OHIO trivia board game to play with your family and friends to test their knowledge too. Lab Fee: \$5. Instructor Amy Stone

- 2. **Mathematics** This class will prepare students for Proficiency and the Ohio Graduation tests. Topics covered are fractions, decimals, algebra and much more. Instructor: John Mulrooney
- 3. **U.S. Presidents Facts and Fun** Come learn more about the 44 men who have lead our country. This class is all about learning fun facts, trivia and other knowledge about our U.S. Presidents that you may not have learned at school. You will be creating a presidential trivia board game to play with your family and friends to test their knowledge too. Lab Fee: \$5 Instructor: Amy Stone
- 4. **History of World War II** Why was Pearl Harbor attacked? We will discuss the reasons and results of World War II and provide hands-on materials, autographs, pictures and possibly guest speakers who are actual World War II Veterans. Instructor: John Mulrooney
