Annual Fairfield County Recycling Survey

The Lancaster-Fairfield Community Action Agency has been providing drop off recycling service to Fairfield County since 1999. Currently, there are 24 drop off trailer sites located throughout the County. At these drop off trailers, residents can recycle their paper, #1 and #2 plastic bottles/jugs, corrugated cardboard, glass bottles/jars, aluminum cans and tin cans. These materials are routinely picked and transferred to the Lancaster-Fairfield Community Action Recycling Center for further processing and prepared for shipment to various markets. The funding for this program is made possible through the CFLP (Coshocton, Fairfield, Licking and Perry County) Solid Waste district. Our goal is to conserve natural resources and divert waste from our landfills.
