Skin Conditions:

- acne
- athlete's foot
- chicken pox
- cold, canker, mouth sores
- dermatitis, rashes & skin irritations

Minor Illness:

- allergy symptoms
- earaches
- flu-like symptoms
- gout
- indigestion
- mononucleosis
- mouth conditions/pain
- nausea/vomiting/diarrhea
- pink eye & styes
- sinus infections/congestion
- sore throat
- upper respiratory infections
- urinary tract infections
- yeast infections

Minor Injuries:

- bug bites & stings
- tick bites
- cholesterol screenings
- minor burns
- minor cuts/blisters/wounds
- splinter removal—superficial
- sprains, strains, joint pains
- suture & staple removal

Screenings:

- basic health screenings
- cholesterol screenings
- glucose screenings
- blood pressure screenings

Wellness/Physicals:

- physicals—basic wellness only
- routine/school/sport/work permit/camp
- ear wax removal
- pregnancy tests
- smoking cessation assessment & follow-up visits
- weight loss assessment & follow-up visits

In-Clinic Lab Tests:

- strep test
- glucose
- mono test
- urine dip stick
- pregnancy test

Vaccines/Injections:

- allergy (must bring serum)
- birth control (must bring medication)
