### What is the UnitedHealth Premium designation program?

To help our members make more informed choices about their selection of physicians we have created a user friendly solution. The UnitedHealth Premium program evaluates physicians using national evidence-based guidelines for quality and local market benchmarks for cost efficiency.

### What is a Tier 1 Physician?

Two-star provider program is now Tier 1. The UnitedHealth Premium Tier 1 symbol can help you find doctors who have been recognized for providing value. If your doctor practices in one of the 23 specialty areas of medicine and is NOT a Tier 1 provider, you will pay a higher co-pay. New specialties have been added to the Premium Tier 1 program and some physicians are no longer Tier 1.
