Prosecuting Attorney Gregg Marx announces that on October 13, 2015, a trial was held where the jury, after only approximately thirty (30) minutes of deliberation, found Jeremy Cheesman guilty of one (1) count of Tampering with Evidence and one (1) count of Illegal Conveyance of Drugs. Both crimes are felonies of the third degree. Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Andrea Green tried the case.

Judge David A. Trimmer will sentence Jeremy Cheesman on October 30, 2015. This incident stems from the Defendant bringing unauthorized prescription medication, concealed in his rectum, into the Fairfield County Jail.
