Arsonist sentenced to seven years

On December 13, 2012, Sherie Bomar entered a guilty plea to Attempted Aggravated Arson, a felony of the second degree. After a contested sentencing, on January 3, 2013, Fairfield County Common Pleas Judge Chris A. Martin sentenced the Defendant to a 7 year sentence in the Ohio Reformatory for Women.

Bomar has a 2002 felony conviction in Fairfield County for Tampering with Evidence arising out of an arson investigation, and also a 1998 Scioto County conviction for Attempted Aggravated Arson.
