

CARROLL BANK ROBBER SENTENCED
April 19, 2012

Billy Caudill of Lancaster entered guilty pleas on August 19, 2012, to Robbery, a felony of the second degree, and Tampering with Evidence, a felony of the third degree. The Defendant was sentenced to 8 years as to the robbery charge to be served consecutively to 36 months as to the tampering with evidence charge for a total prison sentence of 11 years. The 11 year sentence was the maximum that the Defendant could be sentenced to. The Defendant was ordered to pay re restitution to People's Bank in the amount of \$5,460. Caudill also faces up to 2 additional years of prison for a probation violation to be sentenced later this month.

On February 3, 2012, Mr. Caudill was indicted in connection with the robbery occurring on January 25, 2012, at the People's Bank in Carroll, Ohio.
