Welcome

Commissioner Levacy welcomed everyone.

Fairfield Forward

Jonette Haberfield, Visitors & Convention Bureau (VCB), updated the Commission about fun things to do in Fairfield County as we move Fairfield Forward. Please see the attachment, which was in the review packet.

Commissioner Levacy thanked Mr. Haberfield for her update. He thought it went very well.

Dr. Brown thanked Ms. Haberfield for the update and fact sheet and mentioned how good it was to celebrate National Travel & Tourism month with the VCB. There was information about the VCB Open House distributed to meeting participants, too.

Legal Update

Amy Brown-Thompson reported on how Fairfield County prevailed in the Fairfield County v. Franklin County case. There is a 30-day period in which Franklin County will need to decide upon whether or not they will appeal the decision.

Thank you to the entire team for their dedication and professionalism during the court proceedings.

When received, the \$8.575 M plus interest will be paid into the self-funded insurance fund and will be important to the Fairfield County employees and residents.

Articles from the media, past communications, and a memo was in the review packet.

Commissioner Fix discussed with the Board the merits of reverting the employee share of health insurance to 15% (down from 20%) and provided guidance to proceed with this step. He congratulated all who were involved with the court proceedings. He stated this was a big victory for Fairfield County. He went on to describe how the change in the employee share was made last year at the time when it was necessary to secure financial well-being for the county. He believed it was appropriate to make a change now. Commissioner Fix made a motion to reduce the standard employee contribution for the health benefits plan to 15%.

Motion to authorize the HR Department to communicate to all health benefits plan participants the Commission decision to alter the standard employee share for the health benefits plan to 15%, coordinating this change with the County Auditor so that the 15% contribution is effective with the next pay period, and to authorize the County Administrator to coordinate with the HR Department to propose adjustments for accounting measures as needed, keeping the employer share the same amount at this time, anticipating the amount from the Fairfield County v. Franklin County case coming from

On Motion of Jeff Fix and second of Steve Davis, the Fairfield County Board of Commissioner voted to authorize the HR Department to communicate to all health benefits plan participants the Commission decision to alter the standard employee share for the health benefits plan to 15%, coordinating this change with the County Auditor so that the 15% contribution is effective with the next pay period, and to authorize the County Administrator to coordinate with the HR Department to propose adjustments for accounting measures as needed, keeping the employer share the same amount at this time, anticipating the amount from the Fairfield County v. Franklin County case coming from Franklin County will be placed in the self-funded insurance fund as outlined in a Prosecuting Attorney's Opinion from June 5, 2020.

Discussion:

Commissioner Davis stated he supports Commissioner Fix's motion. He stated the Commission has reviewed past decisions and it is time to re-evaluate. When the Commission made the decision to leave Franklin County's Cooperative, it was mathematically and fiscally right regardless of the court decision. He always has thought that Fairfield County deserved the reserve balance back. He stated he appreciated Mr. Porter's, Dr. Brown's, and legal counsel's work on the case. The contract required Fairfield County to give proper notice to withdraw. Fairfield County did give proper notice according to the contract. The contract also said if you do not give timely notice, you will not get your reserve balance back.

Ms. Brown-Thompson stated that she felt like the Court did agree with Commissioner Davis. They gave Franklin County two opportunities to fix things.

Dr. Brown commented that she believed employees will be appreciative of the reduction in the employee share for health benefits. She stated that residents will benefit from the Court's decision because the county will have greater opportunity to control future costs.

Administrative Approvals

The review packet contained a list of administrative approvals. There were no questions.

We are assisting the Governor's Office as communication partners for businesses and organizations who desire to have on-site clinics for COVID19 vaccinations.

Budget Update

- The sales tax estimate for 2021 in Fairfield County is \$23.6 M, or 3% above the sales tax revenues of 2020. We are tracking above this estimate right now.
- We plan to close on new bonds and refinancing on *September 3* and will remain flexible with that timeframe. Dr. Brown met with bond counsel to further this project.
- We are prepared properly to receive American Rescue Plan fiscal recovery funds. The US Treasury portal opened yesterday, and we have requested the first tranche, which will be approximately \$15 Million. There was no adjustment to the county portion anticipated from earlier communications. Commission department heads have already been reviewing the immediate pandemic and health related uses of the funds. The US

Treasury held a webinar last night providing some general information. They believe it will take them several days to process multiple submissions for the first tranches.

Commissioner Davis stated that the American Rescue Plan was originally very broad in its guidelines. Since then, there has been 150+ pages of guidelines that are not so broad. He thanked Dr. Brown and Ms. Cordle for their review of the 150+ pages.

e. BRAVOS

Dr. Brown reported the following Bravos:

- Congratulations to all of the NACO Leadership Academy graduates. There will be presentations of certificates on May 18th.
- Thank you to the team who worked on the Fairfield County v. Franklin County case.

Commissioner Davis stated that the \$10+ million to our health plan is incredibly significant. This could result in years of no increases for employees. Commissioner Levacy agreed with Commissioner Davis. This has been a long process.

COVID-19 Update

Jon Kochs, EMA Director updated the Board of Commissioners on the following vaccination data:

Age Group of 50+ 72% are vaccinated
Age Group of 60+ 76% are vaccinated
Overall of Total Eligible/18+ 52% are vaccinated

Mr. Kochis stated that this is positive for the community.

Joe Ebel, Fairfield Department of Health Commissioner reported that soon Pfizer will be approved for vaccinating the age group of ages 12-15. They hope to expand that group this week. They are currently able to give vaccines to the age groups of 16 & 17. Having that age group vaccinated will help with community spread. The Health Department's clinic is now open on Saturdays at the River Valley Mall. There are a few nights they stay open until 6:00 p.m. They are still seeing a lot of people for their 2nd dose. The amount of 1st dose visitors is slowing down.

New Business

Commissioner Levacy passed around a book to the Board of Commissioners from the Buckeye Lake Region Corporation. Buckeye Lake is within Perry, Licking, and Fairfield counties. The book showed a vision of future development.

Florida governor says it's time to 'believe in the science'

Florida Republican Gov. Ron DeSantis signed a bill Monday suspending local COVID-19 emergency orders in the state and banning "vaccine passports."


