Fairfield County Public Hearing
Community Development Block Grant – PY 2023 – Critical Infrastructure

The Fairfield County Board of Commissioners will hold a second public hearing on Tuesday, May 9, 2023 at 10:30 a.m. to discuss an application for funding from the State of Ohio Community Development Block Grant Program – Critical Infrastructure Program. The meeting will be held in the Commissioners' Meeting Room, Third Floor, 210 East Main Street, Lancaster, Ohio. This is a handicapped accessible facility.

Fairfield County intends to apply for a grant from the Critical Infrastructure Program. Based on both citizen input and local official's assessment of the county's needs, the county is proposing to apply for a sanitary sewer replacement project for the Village of Sugar Grove in association with the CDBG Critical Infrastructure Program for PY 2023.

CDBG programs are federally funded grants which are administered by the Ohio Department of Development. All activities must be designed to primarily benefit low- and moderate-income persons. The Critical Infrastructure Program was created to assist communities with funding for high priority, single-purpose, projects, such as roads, flood and drainage and other public facilities projects with high community-wide impact and that benefit primarily residential areas. Projects may include multiple activities that together contribute to a single failed or failing condition; otherwise, projects with multiple activities will not be considered for funding.
