**New County Utilities “Subdistrict” to Begin Operations April 1, 2018**

**Lancaster, Ohio** – The Board of Fairfield County Commissioners announced today that it is acquiring the Greenfield Water and Sewer District, and the County will begin new operations of a “subdistrict” beginning April 1, 2018. The “subdistrict” has the same physical boundaries as the former Greenfield Water and Sewer District, which is ceasing its operations. The County Utilities Department will be taking over all water and sewer utility operations for the area, after having handled billing for several years.

The change will be seamless to the public and will allow for improved operational efficiencies. Steve Davis, County Commissioner, stated, “We were approached by the Greenfield Water and Sewer District board members who indicated they desired to cease operations and merge with the County. With the County managing the full, ongoing operations, we will be able to be more responsive overall.”
