Cordle has built a distinguished career in labor relations and human resources, earning recognition for her collaborative leadership style, strategic thinking, and commitment to strengthening public sector workplaces. Throughout her career, she has demonstrated a deep understanding of the challenges and opportunities facing public employers.

Cordle previously served as President of the Ohio Public Employer Labor Relations Association (OHPELRA) and currently remains active on its Board. She served previously on the NPELRA Board as Executive Vice President.

As President, Cordle will guide the organization's efforts to provide professional development, advocacy, and resources for labor relations and human resources professionals serving public agencies. Her leadership comes at a critical time as public sector organizations continue to navigate evolving workforce dynamics, labor relations trends, and service delivery expectations.

Cordle has been employed by Fairfield County for more than 35 years, previously serving as the Director of Fairfield County Job and Family Services and as the County's Director of Human Resources.
