Fairfield County Commissioners to Hold New Jail & Public Safety Facility Dedication

Lancaster, Ohio – The Fairfield County Commissioners will formally dedicate the new Jail & Public Safety Facility on Friday, September 29, 2017, at 12:00 p.m. The dedication will mark the completion of the two phase project which broke ground in November of 2015. A ribbon cutting was held in June prior to moving in the Sheriff’s Office and inmates.

Commission President Steve Davis stated, “The facility is 110,000 square feet, combining most of the Sheriff’s operations into one location from four locations. This provides efficiency for the public. We are all pleased to see the project completed on time and on budget.” The facility also institutes modern correctional technology and has repurposed property in the county seat.

The new Jail & Public Safety Facility is located at 345 Lincoln Avenue in Lancaster. The event will begin at 12:00 p.m. on Friday, September 29th. County and community leaders are expected to speak.
