

## NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed proposals for the Village of Thurston Long Street Waterline Upgrade will be received by the Fairfield County Commissioners at their office located at 210 E. Main Street, Lancaster, Ohio 43130 until 9:00 a.m., June 18, 2018, and then at 9:00 a.m. at said office opened and read aloud.

Plans, Specifications, and bid forms may be secured at the office of the Fairfield County Commissioners. An amount of \$40.00 dollars will be required for each set of plans and specifications, check made payable to: CDC of Ohio. The full amount is non-refundable.

Each bid must be accompanied by either a bid bond in an amount of 100% of the bid amount with a surety satisfactory to the aforesaid Fairfield County Commissioners or by certified check, bid bond, cashiers check, or letter of credit upon a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the bid amount in favor of the aforesaid Fairfield County Commissioners. Bid Bonds shall be accompanied by Proof of Authority of the official or agent signing the bond.

The Fairfield County Commissioners reserve the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids. The Engineer's cost estimate with contingencies is Fifty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty Five (\$53,925) Dollars. This project is being funded with Federal CDBG funds.
