The Fairfield County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 27, 2023 at 10:30 a.m. to discuss an application for funding from the State of Ohio CDBG Residential Public Infrastructure Grant. Fairfield County intends to apply for funds from the Residential Public Infrastructure Grant. Based on both citizen input and local official's assessment of the county needs, the county is proposing to apply for a sanitary sewer replacement project for the Village of Carroll in association with the PY 2023 CDBG Residential Public Infrastructure Grant.

CDBG programs are federally funded grants which are administered by the Ohio Department of Development. All activities must be designed to primarily benefit low- and moderate- income persons. The Residential Public Infrastructure Grant was created to assist communities with funding for projects that assist with creating a safe and sanitary living environment for Ohio citizens through the provision of safe and reliable drinking water and proper disposal of sanitary waste.
