Fairfield County Dog Adoption Center & Shelter to Hold Microchip Education Event

Lancaster, Ohio - The Fairfield County Dog Adoption Center & Shelter will be holding a microchip education event on Saturday, October 15th. The first 50 dogs in need of a microchip will be chipped for \$5.00 and will also be registered in the Home Again national database which is accessible by anyone who can scan a microchip. After the first 50 dogs have been microchipped, the fee will be \$10.00 per dog.

The goal of the event is to spread awareness and education on the importance of properly registering microchips. Other important animal care tips will also be addressed. Microchip verification and education will also be available for dogs who have previously been microchipped.

The event will be held from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. in the Ohio University-Lancaster parking lot located at 1570 Granville Pike in Lancaster.
