On _____, this matter was scheduled for a full hearing. In lieu of holding the full hearing, the parties mutually agree to the following Court orders:

- Neither party shall abuse harm, attempt to harm, threaten, follow, stalk, harass, force sexual relations upon, or commit sexually oriented offenses against each other.

- Neither party shall enter the residence, school, business, place of employment, day care centers, or child care providers of the protected persons named in this Order, including the buildings, grounds, and parking lots at those locations.

- Neither party shall interfere with the other party's right to occupy their residence including, but not limited to canceling utilities or insurance or interrupting telephone service, mail delivery, or the delivery of any other documents or items.

- The parties shall stay away from each other, and not be present within _____ feet of each other. If the parties accidentally come in contact with each other in any private or public place, it is the responsibility of the party that is last to arrive to leave as soon as practicable.

- Neither party shall remove, damage, hide, or dispose of any property or pets owned or possessed by the other party.

- The parties shall not initiate or have any contact with each other or with their residences, businesses, places of employment, schools, day care centers, or child care providers. Contact includes but is not limited to phone calls; text messaging; instant messaging; fax; e-mail; voice mail; delivery service; social networking media; blogging; writings; electronic communications; or communications by any other means directly or through another person.

- Neither party shall remove, damage, hide, or dispose of any property or pets owned or possessed by the other party.

- Neither party shall cause or encourage any other person to do an act prohibited by this Agreed Entry.

- Respondent shall not possess, use, carry, or obtain any deadly weapon at any time while this Order remains in effect.

- NCIC information shall be removed from any and all law enforcement databases.
- The designation of Petitioner and Respondent shall be of no significance from a factual or legal standpoint.
- This Agreed Entry does not constitute an admission to any of the allegations set forth in the Petition.
- The terms of this Agreement will expire on _____ .
- The parties acknowledge that violation of these orders may result in contempt of Court.
- Other:

Pursuant to the parties' agreement, the Petition for Civil Stalking Protection Order previously filed is hereby **DISMISSED**. The Fairfield County Sheriff's Department is hereby **ORDERED** to remove any and all NCIC information concerning any *ex parte* Civil Stalking Protection Order issued in this case from its system.
