INTERVENTION IN LIEU OF CONVICTION INFORMATION

During the course of your court case, the Judge has ordered that you need to have an ILC (Intervention in Lieu) Assessment as soon as possible. It is **your responsibility** to schedule your appointment with a provider. Be aware that there are different types of assessments and you need to be clear with your provider which assessment you need. There are Mental Health ILC Assessments and Substance Abuse ILC Assessments. Please be clear with your provider as to which you need. You should **do this as soon as the Judge orders it**, because there could be a waiting list for appointments, and your Assessment needs to be completed in time to allow for the service provider to prepare a final report and recommendation to the Court prior to your ILC hearing. If you don't schedule your appointment in time or you miss your appointment, you need to immediately contact your attorney because the Court cannot proceed without an Assessment.

Below is a list of agencies that have provided ILC Assessments for the Court. You may obtain an assessment from a provider that is not listed below, but please check with your attorney and the Community Control Department first, to make sure that it is an acceptable provider. If you are on Medicaid, an assessment should not cost you anything out-of-pocket. If you do not have insurance, ILC assessments can range from anywhere between \$150 - \$350.
