THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE ANNUAL REPORT

2019 Annual Report

2019 was another productive year for the Fairfield County Engineer's Office. Thanks to another successful Ohio Public Works Commission grant application, we were able to apply \$443,554 in grant money towards two bridge replacement projects. Our office replaced 27 culverts totaling \$379,005 and chip sealed 33.57 miles of roadway for \$502,769. In addition, the Fairfield County Engineer's resurfacing program paved 12.875 miles of roadway for a total of \$1,473,624.

Whenever possible, the Fairfield County Engineer's Office applies for grant money to assist in repairing the roads and bridges in our County. As we end 2019, our office is gearing up for the year 2020. In 2020, we have some major construction projects planned with over \$3 million in grant funding to assist us! Obtaining these extra state and federal grants when they are available give us the ability to apply funds to more projects throughout the year. It is our mission to continue applying for grant money as it becomes available so that we can keep our roadways safe for the traveling public.

2019 Road & Bridge Projects



Our **Madison 8 Bridge** (*pictured left*) on Clearcreek Road was replaced by BUD's, Inc. of Nashport, Ohio for a construction cost of \$333,879. Designed by the Fairfield County Engineer's Office, this simple steel beam bridge was replaced with non-composite prestressed box beams with a reinforced concrete substructure. An OPWC grant helped to fund this project.

The **Violet 35 Bridge** on W. Columbus Street (*pictured right*) was designed by the Fairfield County Engineer's Office. This 14' span x 6'1/2" CMP arch was replaced with a 14' span x 5' rise box culvert. BUD's, Inc. of Nashport, Ohio replaced this bridge for a total construction cost of \$265,519. An OPWC grant helped to fund this project.

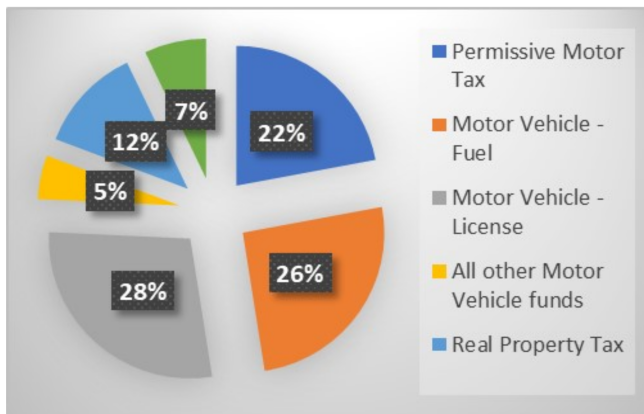


County forces, together with U.S. Bridge of Cambridge, Ohio, rehabilitated the existing superstructure of our **BER-42 Bridge** on Schwilk Road (*pictured below*). U.S. Bridge was awarded this contract for \$154,257.

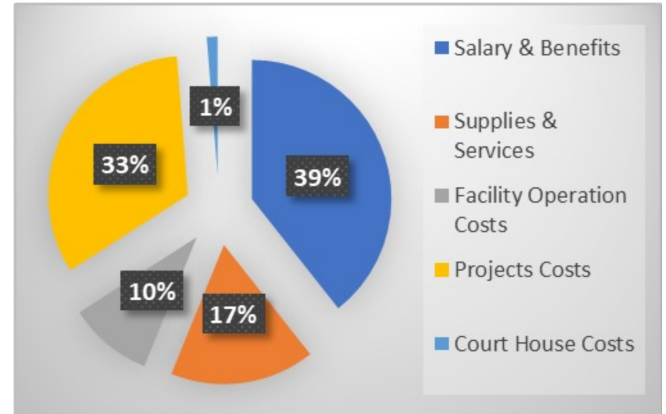


Designed by the Fairfield County Engineer's Office, Seals Construction, Inc. of Canal Winchester, Ohio replaced a 50" x 90" sandstone concrete box with a 60" reinforced concrete pipe on **Lake Road** for \$140,218 (*pictured above*).

ICE AND SNOW CONTROL

Approximately \$340,206 was spent on salt and grits for the 2018-2019 winter season. Road crews purchased approximately 3196 tons of grits and 3638 tons of salt to keep the county road system open. Such treatment is applied at intersections, hills, and curves as first priority. Depending on weather conditions and effectiveness, brine is also used on our arterial routes and some collector routes.

2019 RESURFACING

The Shelly Company of Thornville, Ohio received the 2019 Resurfacing Contract for a total construction cost of \$1,473,624. Resurfacing took place on sections of the following roadways: Winchester-Southern Road, Sixteenth Road, Amanda-Northern Road, Milnor Road, Carroll-Northern Road, and Millersport Road.

CULVERT PROJECTS

County forces replaced 27 culverts in 2019 for a total cost of \$379,005.
