## THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE ANNUAL REPORT

#### 2020 Annual Report

Despite our battle with COVID this year, the Fairfield County Engineer's Office had a very successful construction season. Our office was awarded over \$3 million dollars in grant money for our 2020 construction season. We received \$587,131 in grant money from The Ohio Public Works Commission to replace three bridges. Receiving over \$2.3 million in federal grants this year allowed us to resurface CR33A and make major safety improvements to a critical intersection at Election House Road, North Columbus Street, and 33A. We also teamed up with the Board of Violet Township Trustees to improve the intersection of Basil-Western and Allen Road and oversaw projects for the Boards of Bloom Township Trustees and Clearcreek Township Trustees.

We want to thank State Senator Tim Schaffer for taking the time out of his busy schedule to visit our office. Senator Schaffer toured our Buckeye Lake Flood Mitigation Project, along with several of our county bridges. Senator Schaffer has had a huge part in the Ohio Bridge Partnership Program, an important program that provides federal funding for critical bridge replacement projects across the entire state.

This office will continue to apply for grant money to assist in repairing our roads and bridges in this County. Obtaining these extra state and federal grants when they are available give us the ability to apply funds to more projects throughout the year. It is our mission to continue applying for grant money as it becomes available so that we can keep our roadways safe for the traveling public.

#### 2020 Road & Bridge Projects

Our **Bloom 35 Bridge** on Winchester Road (pictured right) was replaced by BUD's, Inc. of Nashport, Ohio for a construction cost of \$303,301. Designed by the Fairfield County Engineer's Office, this 11' span bridge was replaced with an 8' span x 6' rise box culvert. An OPWC grant helped to fund this project.



Our **Walnut 38 Bridge** on South Bank Road *(pictured right)* was designed by ADR & Associates and constructed by BUD's, Inc. This simple steel beam bridge was replaced by a precast concrete box culvert for a construction cost of \$259,561. An OPWC grant helped to fund this project.



Designed by the Fairfield County Engineer's Office, J&J Bridge Company of New Concord, Ohio replaced this culvert on Coonpath Road for a construction cost of \$165,079. (pictured right).





The **Liberty 45 Bridge** on Poplar Creek Road (pictured left) was designed by E.P. Ferris & Associates. This noncomposite prestressed box beam bridge replaced a steel beam with timber deck structure. J&J Bridge Company of New Concord, Ohio replaced this bridge for a total construction cost of \$313,848. An OPWC grant helped to fund this project.



A federal grant was awarded to our office to replace the guardrail on our BER-34 Bridge located on Sugar Grove Road. *(pictured left)* Axis Civil Construction of Columbus, Ohio was awarded this contract. Construction costs totaled \$226,706.



The Board of Violet Township Trustees was awarded an OPWC grant for intersection improvements at Allen Road and Basil-Western Road. (pictured left) The Fairfield County Engineer's Office teamed up with Violet Township to share in the local costs. Construction costs totaled \$316,187.





CR33A was resurfaced this year by The Shelly Company out of Thornville, Ohio. *(pictured above)* A federal grant covered \$2M of our \$3,180,095 construction cost.





Intersection improvements took place this year at the intersection of Election House Road, N. Columbus Street, and CR33A. *(pictured above)* Designed by the GPD Group, this project consisted of a traffic signal addition at the intersection of Election House Road and CR33A, and the conversion of N. Columbus Street to right-in/right-out access at Election House Road. Complete General Construction of Columbus, Ohio was awarded this contract. Construction costs totaled \$380,079. A federal grant helped to fund this project.

#### ICE AND SNOW CONTROL

Approximately \$281,267 was spent on salt, grits, and snow fence for the 2019-2020 winter season. Road crews purchased approximately 1010 tons of grits and 3056 tons of salt to keep the county road system open. Such treatment is applied at intersections, hills, and curves as first priority. Depending on weather conditions and effectiveness, brine is also used on our arterial routes and some collector routes.


#### 2020 RESURFACING

The Shelly Company of Thornville, Ohio received the 2020 Resurfacing Contract for a total construction cost of \$549,458. Resurfacing took place on sections of the following roadways: Hill Road, Pickerington Road, and Coonpath Road.
