

Coronet Awards

What is a Coronet Award? The award honors homeowners, business owners, industry, schools, churches, and public property that have undergone significant improvements in landscaping, restoration, or renovation each year. Any project can be large or small, but it must be visible to a passerby. The public and the Fairfield County Heritage Association members can nominate properties for the award. The Coronet Award committee selects the winners. The winners will receive a plaque and a one-year membership to the Fairfield County Heritage Association.

Working in conjunction with the Fairfield County Heritage Association, we were able to compile a list of approximately 310 winners dating back to 1967. Due to out of date records, address changes, demolished buildings and other unforeseen circumstances, about 30 of those winners are not represented on this map.
