First Students of Mount Carmel College of Nursing at Fairfield Medical Center Set to Graduate May 5

LANCASTER, **Ohio (May 3, 2012)** – The music of "Pomp and Circumstance" will herald the arrival this weekend of the first graduates of Mount Carmel College of Nursing at Fairfield Medical Center (MCCN FMC). A total of 15 MCCN FMC students will receive their Bachelor of Science in nursing degrees, joining students from the college's main campus at ceremonies to be held on Saturday, May 5 at 1 p.m. at First Church of God on Refugee Road in Columbus.

"As Fairfield Medical Center's first class to graduate, I can't say enough about how dedicated and committed this class has been," said Cynthia Pearsall, MSN, RN, FMC chief nursing officer.
