### PARENT EDUCATION CLASS – CHILDREN IN BETWEEN® –

The Fairfield County Domestic Relations Court offers to all parents in divorce, legal separation, or dissolution actions, in which there are minor children, an educational seminar sponsored by the Domestic Relations Division of the Fairfield County Common Pleas Court. The purpose of this Parent Education Class, Children In Between®, is to teach parents how to support and assist their children as they adapt to changing family relationships.

#### There are two Children In Between® Class options:

<u><b>In-Person Class – FREE</b></u>	<u><b>Online Class - \$45.95</b></u>
<p>The three-hour sessions are offered twice per month: one weeknight evening session and one Saturday session.</p> <p>Classes are held at the <b>Fairfield County Visitation Center located at 227 East Main Street in Lancaster, Ohio.</b></p> <p>Each parent must report to class 5 minutes before the scheduled start time.
