



Behavior Support Strategist

The Fairfield County Board of Developmental Disabilities is seeking a Behavior Support Strategist. The chosen. This position will be responsible in assisting with coordinating, writing, developing, monitoring, and training on identified actions that pose risk of harm for adults/children who receive Behavior Support Services. This position will also focus on supportive environments that mitigate the risk of harm or legal sanction and ultimately reduce and/or eliminate the need for restrictive measures.

A Bachelor's Degree in related field is required; OR all of the following: completion of 3 years college level education with 5 years paid work experience in the field and completion of a Bachelor's degree within 1 year of beginning position.

As an employee of the Fairfield County Board of Developmental Disabilities, the job incumbent shall comply with all Board policies, and shall demonstrate respect for, support dignity of, and observe the rights of all individuals served by the agency.

The hourly rate range for this position is \$19.73-\$28.19 and is based upon experience and qualifications and includes full county benefits.
