



Fairfield County Utilities Department Wastewater Operator-in-Training

The Fairfield County Utilities Department is accepting applications for a Wastewater Operator-in-Training. This position is responsible for assisting in the performance of daily operations of wastewater treatment facilities. Other duties associated with this position include, but are not limited to: monitoring and recording all flows at the wastewater treatment plant, including plant influent and effluent flows; performing various chemical, biological and bacterial testing and analysis required by federal and state regulatory agencies; performing sampling and processing control testing to maintain proper levels of flows, waste/return sludge rates, solids inventory and solids mass balances; performing routine maintenance of valves, pumps, piping and related equipment necessary for the operation and maintenance of the treatment of wastewater; assisting in the repair of broken mains and related appurtenances and equipment in the collection system; assisting in performing sewer service line connection inspections; assisting with sludge management plan; and performing general housekeeping and groundskeeping duties.

The mission of Fairfield County is to ensure high quality services at an exceptional value to taxpayers. Successful candidates will further the mission of the Fairfield County Commissioners and provide exemplary service to the public. The successful candidate must follow county policies and exhibit a professional demeanor at all times.

Candidates for this position must have a high school diploma or equivalent and a valid State of Ohio Class A CDL with tanker endorsement (or the ability to obtain within 1 year). The successful candidate will be required to obtain a Class I Wastewater Operator license according to Ohio EPA Certification within 18 months. Excellent customer service and computer skills are required.

This is a full-time position with occasional on call hours. The starting rate of pay for this position is \$12.40 per hour, based on experience and qualifications and is offered full county benefits.
