## **Pre-Bid Meeting Questions**

- QUESTION: Is the 1.5" mill/fill, correct? Would Fairfield County consider adding a .5" leveling course to the specifications? ANSWER: Yes, Fairfield County will add a .5" leveling course to the bid packet as Addendum #1.
- 2. QUESTION: Is the finish course to be included in the full-depth repair? ANSWER: No, the 1.5" finish course should be part of the total square yards for the resurfacing project.
- 3. QUESTION: Are new parking blocks to be included in the bid? ANSWER: No, the existing parking blocks should be removed and replaced after the new pavement. Any blocks broken during construction will be evaluated by the owner and replaced as needed.
- 4. QUESTION: Should we plan on removing and replacing the "Visitor Parking Only" signs?
  ANSWER: Yes, plan on removing and replacing these four (4) signposts. Replace posts using 2.5" square posts per ODOT 730 TRAFFIC SIGN AND SUPPORT MATERIAL specifications. Re-install the existing signs to new 2.5" square posts.
- 5. QUESTION: What is the availability of the parking lot? Can we work throughout the week?

ANSWER: Yes, it is possible to work throughout the week on the project. We can make half (1/2) of the parking lot available to contractors during building work hours (7:00am-4:30pm). Coordination will be critical IF the contractor decides to work during building work hours (7:00am-4:30pm), as there are numerous employees and customers utilizing the building throughout the week. WE ENCOURAGE CONTRACTORS TO CONSIDER WEEKEND AND AFTER HOUR WORK, IF AT ALL POSSIBLE.

6. QUESTION: Are the dimensions of the parking lot on the plans? ANSWER: *No, the plans are not to scale.*
