

Fairfield County COVID-19 SERVICES UPDATE



Real Estate Taxes are Accepted with Convenient Options:

- Regular mail (an envelope will be included with County Treasurer notices).
- Payment by check or money order is accepted at the drive-thru at 135 W. Chestnut St. in Lancaster, M-F, from 9 a.m.-4 p.m.
- On-line payment (with credit card or electronic check only) go to www.co.fairfield.oh.us/treasurer/.
- Use of the drop box at 210 E. Main St. in Lancaster (clearly mark the envelope).

The County Administrative (Historic) Courthouse at 210 E. Main St. in Lancaster, will open from 9 a.m.-3 p.m., M-F, beginning June 15, for the purpose of collecting real estate tax payments in Room 104.

People should use the public entrance at Main St. on the ground floor. If you are paying for more than ten parcels, please call the County Treasurer at 740-652-7140 for an appointment.

Please note that all other business in the building will continue to require an appointment.

- Beginning, June 1, the OhioMeansJobs Center at JFS, 239 W. Main St., will be open to those seeking employment M-F, from 8 a.m.-4 p.m.

All other services are open to the public by scheduled meetings, hearings, and appointments. The use of buildings continues to follow state and federal guidance.
