

## FAIRFIELD COUNTY FISCAL YEAR 2017 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

The Fairfield County Board of Commissioners will hold a second public hearing concerning the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Critical Infrastructure Grant Program on June 27, 2017 at 10:30 AM in the Commissioners Hearing Room, third floor, 210 East Main Street Lancaster, Ohio. This is a handicapped accessible facility.

Fairfield County is eligible to apply for a grant from the Critical Infrastructure Program. Based on both citizen input and local official's assessment of the county's needs, the county is proposing to undertake projects for the Village of Baltimore in association with the CDBG Critical Infrastructure Program for FY 2017.

Activities being considered include:

1. \$196,500 Repair Water Street Bridge and Relocate Exposed Water Line
2. \$20,000 Administration

The second public hearing will be June 27, 2017 at 10:30 AM in the Commissioners Hearing Room, third floor, 210 East Main Street Lancaster, Ohio. This will give citizens an opportunity to review and comment on the County's proposed CDBG application, including the proposed activities summarized above, before the County's application is processed by the Ohio Development Service Agency.

Citizens and local officials are encouraged to attend this meeting on June 27, 2017, to express their views and comments on the County's proposed CDBG program.
