#### 4. MORPC Presentation

Mr. Borger thinks it is perfect timing for Fairfield County to do an update to their active transportation plan. CORPO does have dedicated funds available that could be applied to things which come out of our update. The group had some general questions to MORPC regarding an update to the plan. After some discussion it was agreed that MORPC would send RPC a scope of work for the update to the Active Transportation plan.
