

FAIRFIELD COUNTY FISCAL YEAR 2018 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

The Fairfield County Board of Commissioners will hold a second public hearing concerning the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Allocation Program, Neighborhood Revitalization Program and Critical Infrastructure Program on Tuesday May 8, 2018 at 10:30AM in the Commissioners Hearing Room, third floor, 210 East Main Street Lancaster, Ohio. This is a handicapped accessible facility.

Fairfield County is eligible for \$302,000 of Fiscal Year 2018 CDBG funding from the Allocation Program providing the County meets applicable program requirements. The County has conducted one public hearing to inform citizens about the various CDBG programs, how they may be used, what activities are eligible and other important program requirements. The County has also conducted a Community Development Implementation Strategy meeting.

Fairfield County is eligible to apply for a grant from the Neighborhood Revitalization Program. Based on both citizen input and local official's assessment of the county's needs, the county is proposing to undertake projects for the Village of Millersport in association with the CDBG Neighborhood Revitalization Program for FY 2018.

Fairfield County is eligible to apply for a grant from the Critical Infrastructure Program. Based on both citizen input and local official's assessment of the county's needs, the county is proposing to undertake projects for the Village of Sugar Grove in association with the CDBG Critical Infrastructure Program for FY 2018.

The second public hearing will be held Tuesday May 8, 2018 at 10:30AM in the Commissioners Hearing Room, third floor, 210 East Main Street Lancaster, Ohio. This will give citizens an opportunity to review and comment on the County's proposed CDBG application, before the County's application is processed by the Ohio Development Service Agency.

Citizens and local officials are encouraged to attend this meeting on May 8, 2018, to express their views and comments on the County's proposed CDBG program. Large print materials and auxiliary aids will be made available, if requested in advance.
